

Utah WIC Program Anticipated Participation – Fiscal Year 2024

Utah WIC has seen significant increases in our caseload in the past year. It is anticipated that participation rates in the Utah WIC program for FY23 may continue to increase at a rate of approximately 10% from June 23 to June 24. This is likely due to the high inflation rates of the economy, the value of the Cash Value Benefit increases, the decrease in SNAP benefits, and our modernization efforts. Utah WIC is working on additional modernization of technology projects to make program participation easier and more desirable. Utah's economy remains strong and the labor shortage continues.

Children participants: 22,551

Infants: 9,405
