

Income Guidelines

- I. At each certification visit, total household income for each family must be recorded in VISION by a WIC staff member. Income is based on gross household income. (See Income Exclusions.) The clinic must determine that the applicant's income is at or below 185% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines published annually in the Federal Register.
- II. Anyone whose income exceeds the limit for their household size is not eligible for WIC unless adjunctively income eligible, as described in the Adjunct Eligibility section.
- III. The following table defines the income limits for the Utah WIC Program, effective July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016. Total household income must be at or below the amounts listed in order to meet income eligibility requirements.
