Peanut butter and beans — more information

Peanut butter and beans are issued in units of jar/bag. 1 jar/bag of legumes equals:



or



or









1 jar (15 to 18 ounces [oz]) equals 1 jar/bag

1 bag (16 oz) dried beans equals 1 jar/bag

4 cans (15 to 16 oz) of beans equals 1 jar/bag (1 can equals 0.25 jar/bag)

There are many combinations and different ways you can use your peanut butter and beans benefit. Here are some examples:
